



CROWNPOINT NAVAJO CULTURE TOUR

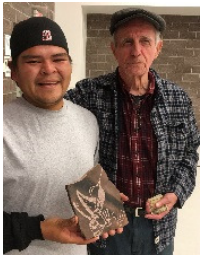
**Departs Albuquerque the 2nd Fri of each month @ 3PM,

Enjoy a guided tour to the Crownpoint Navajo rug auction that brings weavers and buyers together in the heart of Indian Country. Tour New Mexico guides have led cultural tours of the American Southwest for over two decades. Their expertise in the history and their knowledge of prehistoric as well as contemporary culture is complemented by their caring personalities, passion for the land and people plus a pleasing sense of humor.

Friday



Ya'at'eeh. Welcome to Tour New Mexico's fascinating overnight trip to the Navajo Nation. The tour departs from a secure parking lot at the Sunport. We will travel in comfort to Crownpoint, on the Navajo Reservation, in a Mercedes Sprinter. Don't worry, we will take a restroom break in Grants at the El Malpais Visitor Center. Arrive at the Crownpoint Elementary School with time to shop for jewelry and pottery,

and to preview the rugs. You can smell the wonderful Navajo Tacos being prepared by the local school children. The most exciting way to purchase an item is at a live auction conducted by a professional auctioneer.



On the drive to Crownpoint, your guide will give you tips on what to look for when choosing a rug. Even if you do not purchase a rug, the auction is truly immersion into Navajo culture and an experience you will not soon forget. After the auction we will head to the new Fairfield Inn, in Gallup.

Saturday



The day begins with a bountiful breakfast, included. Then it's off to historic Route 66 in Gallup to visit Richardson's Trading Post. This authentic trading post has been in business for over 100 years. Richardson's is known for its amazing collection of Native American Art and the traditional pawn counter. The next stop is the El Rancho Hotel. This beautiful hotel was home to many movie stars making westerns during the 30's & 40's. John Wayne, Gregory Peck, Humphrey Bogart and Betty Gable enjoyed El Rancho's hospitality.

From Gallup we will make the short drive to the Navajo Capitol, Window Rock, AZ. We visit the famous Window Rock formation and the Monument to the Navajo Code Talkers. We'll have lunch and visit the Navajo Nation Museum, departing Window Rock by 3pm to arrive in Albuquerque at 6pm, approximately.

We look forward to having you join us on this unique, fun filled overnight.
